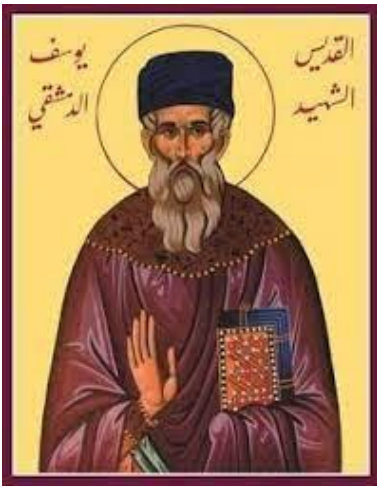

HIEROMARTYR JOSEPH OF DAMASCUS & HIS COMPANIONS & FOURTH SUNDAY OF MATTHEW

THE 45 MARTYRS AT NIKOPOLIS IN ARMENIA; VENERABLE ANTHONY OF THE KIEV CAVES;
VENERABLE-MARTYRS NIKODEMOS THE ALBANIAN AND NEKTARIOS OF ST. ANNE SKETE ON ATHOS

SAINT JOSEPH OF DAMASCUS



Saint Joseph of Damascus, as he is commonly known, was a weaver by trade. After he was married and ordained to the priesthood, Joseph was assigned Great Ekonomos of the Patriarchal Cathedral of the Dormition of the Most Holy Theotokos (al-Mariamiyeh) in the heart of the Old City of Damascus. On Monday, July 9, 1860, the brutal massacre of Christians which began in the Lebanese mountains spread to Damascus. Some Damascenes (including Michael Hawaweeny and his young wife Mariam who was bearing in her womb a son, the future Saint Raphael), fled the city for Beirut. The majority, however, took refuge in al-Mariamiyeh. Joseph took up his communion kit containing the Reserved Sacrament, left his home and began to make his way to the Cathedral by jumping from rooftop to rooftop in the Old City. As he went, he stopped to confess and commune the aged and infirm who could not flee their

homes, encouraging them with stories from the Lives of the Great Martyrs. On the morning of Tuesday, July 10, the Cathedral was surrounded, pillaged and burned. Those inside perished in the flames; of those who escaped and fled into the streets, most were caught and forced back into the burning building, while only a few, including Father Joseph, survived. As he roamed the narrow streets searching for survivors who needed confession and communion, Joseph was surrounded by the enemies of Christ. Seeing that his end was near, Saint Joseph took out his communion kit and consumed what remained of the Body and Blood of Christ. Recognizing him as the "leader of the Christians," the persecutors savagely attacked and killed him with axes. Joseph and his Companions were glorified by the Holy Synod of Antioch in 1993.

THE EPISTLE

The saints shall boast in glory, and they shall rejoice upon their beds.

Sing unto the Lord a new song; His praise is in the church of the saints.

The Reading from the Second Epistle of St. Paul to St. Timothy. (2:1-10)

Timothy, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus; and what you have heard from me before many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also. Share in suffering as a good soldier of Christ Jesus. No soldier on service gets entangled in civilian pursuits, since his aim is to satisfy the one who enlisted him. An athlete is not crowned unless he competes according to the rules. It is the hard-working farmer who ought to have the first share of the crops. Think over what I say, for the Lord will grant you understanding in everything. Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, descended from David, as preached in my gospel, the gospel for which I am suffering and wearing fetters like a criminal. But the word of God is not fettered. Therefore, I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain salvation in Christ Jesus with its eternal glory.

يا ولدي تيموثاوس، تَقَوَّ في النِّعْمَةِ التي في الْمَسِيحِ يَسُوعَ. وما سَمِعْتَهُ مِنِّي لَدَى شُهُودِ كَثِيرِينَ، اسْتَوْدِعْهُ أَناساً
أَمْناءَ كُفُوءاً لَأَنْ يُعَلِّمُوا آخَرِينَ أَيْضاً. احْتَمِلِ الْمَشَقَّاتِ كَجُنْدِيِّ صَالِحٍ لِيَسُوعِ الْمَسِيحِ. لَيْسَ أَحَدٌ يَتَجَنَّدُ فَيَرْتَبِكُ بِهُمُومِ

الْمَسِيحِ، الَّذِي مِنْ نَسْلِ دَاوُدَ، قَدْ قَامَ مِنْ بَيْنِ الْأَمْواتِ عَلَى حَسَبِ إِنْجِيلِي. الَّذِي أَحْتَمِلُ فِيهِ الْمَشَقَّاتِ حَتَّى الْقُبُودِ
كَمُجْرِمٍ، إِلَّا أَنْ كَلِمَةَ اللَّهِ لَا تُفَيْدُ. فَلِذَلِكَ أَنَا أَصْبِرُ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ مِنْ أَجْلِ الْمُخْتَارِينَ، لِكَيْ يَحْصُلُوا هُمْ أَيْضاً عَلَى
الْخَلَاصِ الَّذِي فِي الْمَسِيحِ يَسُوعَ، مَعَ الْمَجْدِ الْأَبَدِيِّ.

THE GOSPEL

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew. (8:5-13)

At that time, as Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion came forward to him, beseeching Him and saying, "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, in terrible distress." And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him." But the centurion answered Him, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come under my roof; but only say the word, and my servant will be healed. For I am a man under authority, with soldiers under me; and I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come,' and he comes, and to my slave, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard him, He marveled, and said to those who followed him, "Truly, I say to you, not even in Israel have I found such faith. I tell you, many will come from east and west and sit at table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the Kingdom of Heaven, while the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness; there men will weep and gnash their teeth." And to the centurion Jesus said, "Go; be it done for you as you have believed." And the servant was healed at that very moment.

في ذلك الزمان، دَخَلَ يَسُوعُ كَفَرْنَاحُومَ، فَدَنَا إِلَيْهِ قَائِدُ مِئَةٍ، وَطَلَبَ إِلَيْهِ قَائِلًا: يَا رَبُّ إِنْ فَتَايَ مُلْقَى فِي الْبَيْتِ مُخْلَعًا
يُعَذَّبُ بِعَذَابٍ شَدِيدٍ. فَقَالَ لَهُ يَسُوعُ: أَنَا آتِي وَأَشْفِيهِ. فَأَجَابَ قَائِدُ الْمِئَةِ قَائِلًا: يَا رَبُّ، لَسْتُ مُسْتَحِقًّا أَنْ تَدْخُلَ تَحْتَ

لَكُمْ، إِنِّي لَمْ أَجِدْ إِيمَانًا بِمِثْلِ هَذَا وَلَا فِي إِسْرَائِيلَ. أَقُولُ لَكُمْ، إِنَّ كَثِيرِينَ سَيَأْتُونَ مِنَ الْمَشَارِقِ وَالْمَغَارِبِ وَيَتَّكُونَ مَعَ
إِبْرَاهِيمَ وَاسْحَقَ وَيَعْقُوبَ فِي مَلَكُوتِ السَّمَاوَاتِ. وَأَمَّا بَنُو الْمَلَكُوتِ فَيُلْقُونَ فِي الظُّلْمَةِ الْبَرَّانِيَّةِ. هُنَاكَ يَكُونُ الْبُكَاءُ
وَصْرِيْفُ الْأَسْنَانِ. ثُمَّ قَالَ يَسُوعُ لِقَائِدِ الْمِئَةِ: اذهب، وَليكنْ لَكَ كَمَا آمَنْتَ. فَشَفِيَ فَتَاهُ فِي تِلْكَ السَّاعَةِ.
