FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST & FOURTH SUNDAY OF MATTHEW

RIGHTEOUS FATHERS JOHN OF EDESSA IN MESOPOTAMIA & SIMEON OF HOMS (EMESA), THE FOOL-FOR-CHRIST



<u>Righteous Fathers John of Edessa and Simeon of Homs,</u> <u>Fools-for-Christ</u>

On July 21 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate our Righteous Fathers John of Edessa in Mesopotamia; and Simeon of Homs (Emesa), the Fool-for-Christ.

Both men received the monastic tonsure at the hands of the Abbot Nicon in the Monastery of St. Gerasimos. They withdrew into the wilderness near the Dead Sea where they lived an austere life of asceticism for nearly thirty years. They mortified their bodies so much that they resembled two withered trees. One day Simeon told John that, according to God's command, he must depart from the wilderness, go among the people and serve God there. John said to Simeon, "Pray to God for me, that He does not separate us, one from the other, in the future life." Simeon went among the people of Homs, Syria as a "fool for Christ," to teach people and to convert them to the Faith of

Christ. He pretended insanity before everyone but his heart was the temple of the Holy Spirit and, in that temple, was unceasing prayer. Simeon possessed abundant grace from God and was able to discern all the inner secrets of people, healing them from evil spirits and other ailments. Simeon came across a young fornicator who went out of his mind. Simeon struck him across the face with his hand and said: "Do not commit fornication." At that moment the unclean demon departed from the young man and he became well. Simeon reposed in 570; by the providence of God, John, who had remained in the wilderness, departed soon after.

THE EPISTLE

Sing praises to our God, sing praises. Clap your hands all ye peoples.

The Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Romans. (6:18-23)

Brethren, having been set free from sin, you have become slaves of righteousness. I am speaking in human terms, because of your natural limitations. For just as you once yielded your members to impurity and to greater and greater iniquity, so now yield your members to righteousness for sanctification. When you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. But then what return did you get from the things of which you are now ashamed? The end of those things is death. But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the return you get is sanctification and its end, eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

THE GOSPEL

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew. (8:5-13)

At that time, as Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion came forward to him, beseeching Him and saying, "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, in terrible distress." And Jesus said to him, "I will come and heal him." But the centurion answered Him, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come under my roof; but only say the word, and my servant will be healed. For I am a man under authority, with soldiers under me; and I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come,' and he comes, and to my slave, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard him, He marveled, and said to those who followed him, "Truly, I say to you, not even in Israel have I found such faith. I tell you, many will come from east and west and sit at table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the Kingdom of Heaven, while the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness; there men will weep and gnash their teeth." And to the centurion Jesus said, "Go; be it done for you as you have believed." And the servant was healed at that very moment.

فَصْلٌ شَرِيفٌ مِنْ بِشارَةِ القِدِّيسِ مَ[َ]تَّى ٱلْإِنْجِيلِى البَشير والتِلْميذِ الطاهِرِ. في ذلكَ الزمان، دَخَلَ يَسوعُ كَفْرَناحومَ، فَدَنا إليهِ قائِدُ مِنَةٍ، وطَّلَبَ إليْهِ قائلاً: يا رَبُّ إنَّ فتايَ مُلْقىَ في البَيْتِ مُخَلَّعاً يُعَذَّبُ بِعَذابِ شَديدٍ. فقالَ لَهُ يَسوعُ: أنا آتى وأَشْفِيهِ. فأَجابَ قائِدُ المِئَةِ قائِلاً: يا رَبُّ، لَسْتُ مُسْتَحقًاً أَنْ تَدْخُلَ تَحْتَ سَقْفِي، ولَكِنْ قُلْ كَلِمَةً لا غَيْرُ، فَيْبَراً فَتايَ. فإنّى أنا إنسانٌ تَحْتَ سُلُطان، ولى جُندٌ تَحْتَ يدي

فَيَذْهَبُ، ولُلَآخَر "أَنْتِ"، فَيَأْتَى، ولعَبْديَ "اعْمَلْ هذا"، فَيَعْمَلُ. فَلَمَّا سَمِعَ يَسوعُ، تَعَجَّبَ وقالَ للذينَ يَتْبَعونَهُ: الحَقَّ أقولُ لَكُمْ، إنّى لَمْ أَجِدْ إيماناً بِمِقْدار هَذا ولا في إسْرائيل. أقولُ لَكُمْ، إنَّ كَثيرينَ سَيَأْتُونَ مِنَ المَشارقِ والمَغارِبِ ويَتَّكَئُونَ معَ إبراهيمَ واسْحَقَ ويَعْقُوبَ في مَلَكوتِ السَّماواتِ. وأمَّا بَنو المَلَكوتِ فَيُلْقَونَ في الظُلمَةِ البَرَّانيَّةِ. هُناكَ يَكونُ البُكاءُ وصَرِيفُ الأَسْنان. ثُمَّ قَالَ يَسوعُ لِقائِدِ المِئَةِ: اذْهَبْ، ولْيَكُنْ لكَ كَما آمَنْتَ. فَشُفيَ فَتاهُ في تِلْكَ السَاعَة.

Building Committee Update:

As you can see, the exterior of the fellowship hall is nearing completion. The doors and windows are in and exterior tiles are being applied. Inside the hall insulation is being installed and drywall is going up. Additionally, the preschool playground area is being mapped out and final designs for equipment are being determined. Final details for the hardscape from the new parking to the entrance of the hall is being finalized and will begin soon.

There is still much to be done on the interior before we complete the project such as the kitchen, restrooms, some lighting, and floor, wall and ceiling treatments, but we are nearing the point where building funds are being depleted. The parish council, building committee, contractor and fundraising committee are meeting to strategize next steps for the final fundraising push to complete the project. With God's help, we will be able to raise the funds to bring the building to completion soon.

Fundraising Committee Update:

The Fundraising Committee, along with the contractor,

and the Building Committee will be meeting with the Parish Council to look at fundraising opportunities for completing the Fellowship Hall.
