Sunday of the Veneration of the Cross

On the Third Sunday of the Fast, we keep the feast of the Veneration of the honorable and life-creating Cross.

Every hard and strenuous work is accomplished with great difficulty, which appears especially in the middle of such work; for the effort in this performance brings with it fatigue which makes the accomplishment of the rest difficult. Having arrived with God's grace at the middle of the Fast, our compassionate Mother—the Holy Orthodox Church—thought fit to reveal to us the Holy Cross as the joy of the world and power of the faithful to help us carry on the struggles of the divine Fast.

By its power, O Christ God, preserve us from the crafty designs of the evil one and account us worthy to worship Thy divine Passion and life-giving Resurrection, as we achieve the course of the Forty Days with ease, and have mercy on us, as Thou alone art good and the Lover of mankind. Amen.

THE EPISTLE

O Lord, save Thy people and bless Thine inheritance. Unto Thee, O Lord, will I cry, O my God!

The Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Hebrews. (4:14-5:6)

Brethren, since we have a great High Priest, Who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast the confession. For we do not have a High Priest Who is unable to sympathize with our infirmities, but one Who has been in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore draw near with boldness to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy, and may find grace to help in time of need. For every high priest, being taken from among the people, is appointed on behalf of the people in things pertaining to God, that he may offer up both gifts and sacrifices for sins; who can have compassion on the ignorant and on those who are erring, since he himself also is encompassed with infirmity. Because of this he is bound, as for the people so also for himself, to offer up for sins. And no one takes the honor upon himself, but as being called by God, as was Aaron. So Christ also did not glorify Himself to become a High Priest, but it was by the One saying to Him, "Thou art My Son, today I have begotten Thee." As He says also in another place, "Thou art a Priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek".

خَلِّصْ يَا رَبُّ شَعْبَكَ وِبَارِكُ مِيراتَكَ اللِّيكَ يَا رِبُّ أَصْرُخُ إِلْهِي. فَصْلٌ مِنْ رسالَةِ القِدّيس بولُسَ الرَّسول إلى العِبرانِيين. (14:4-6:5)

"يا إِخْوَةُ، إِذْ لنا رَئيسُ كَهَنَةٍ عَظيمٌ قَدِ اجْتازَ السَّمَاواتِ، يَسوعُ ابنُ اللهِ، فَلنَتَمَسَّكْ بالإعْتِرافِ. لأنَّ ليسَ لَنا رئيسُ كَهَنَةٍ غَيْرُ قادِر أَنْ يَرِثِيَ لأَوهانِنا، بلْ مُجَرَّبُ في كُلِّ شيءٍ مِثْلَنَا ما خَلا الخَطيئَة. فَلْنُقْبلْ إذَنْ بثِقَةٍ إلى عَرْشِ النِّعمَةِ، لِنَنالَ رَحْمَةً ونَجَّد ثِقَةً لِلْإَغاثَةِ في أُوانِها. فإنَّ كُلَّ رئيس كَهَنَةٍ مُتَّخَذٍ مِنَ الناس يُقامُ لأَجْلِ النَّاس فيما هُوَ للهِ، ليُقَرّبَ تَقادِمَ وذَبائِحَ عَن الخَطايا، في إمْكانِهِ أَنْ يُشْفِقَ على الذينَ يَجْهَلونَ ويَضِلُّونَ، لِكَوْنِهِ هُوَ أَيْضااً مُتَابَساً بالضُّعْفِ. ولِهَذا يَجِبُ عَلَيْهِ أَنْ يُقَرّبَ عَن الخَطايا لأَجْلِ نَفْسِهِ كَما يُقَرّبُ لأَجْلِ الشَّعْبِ. وَأَيْسَ أَحَدٌ يأْخُذُ لنَفْسِهِ الكَرامَةَ، بَلْ مَنْ دَعَاهُ اللهُ كَما دَعا هارون. كَذَلِكَ المَسيحُ لَمْ يُمَجِّدْ نَفْسَهُ لِيَصيرَ رَئيسَ كَهَنَةٍ، بَلِ الذي قالَ لهُ "أنتَ ابْني وأنا اليَوْمَ وَلَدْتُكَ." كَما يَقُولُ في مَوْضِع آخَرَ "أنتَ كاهنٌ إلى الأبَد على رُثْبَةِ مَلكيصادَق."

THE GOSPEL

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Mark. (8:34-9:1)

The Lord said, "If any man would come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me. For whoever would save his life will lose it; and whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel's will save it. For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul? For what can a man give in return for his soul? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of man also be ashamed, when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels." And Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the kingdom of God come with power."
